Guidelines

The Brookfield Theatre for the Arts, a 501(c)(3) non-profit arts organization, announces the TBTA Scholarship Awards Program. Scholarships of \$100 will be awarded to high school seniors studying in Brookfield, Connecticut or the neighboring towns of Sherman, New Milford, Washington, Bridgewater, Roxbury, Newtown, or Danbury who are pursuing college studies in theater arts.

Guidelines:

- The candidate is graduating from high school in the Brookfield region as described above
- The candidate is pursuing studies in Theater Arts at an accredited college or university
- The candidate has been actively involved in theater arts in the greater Brookfield region
- The candidate has been involved in non-school sponsored activities
- The candidate shows a commitment to volunteerism and community service

Essav:

Candidates who wish to may submit a brief essay (no more than 1 page) describing how participation in performing arts have impacted their lives.

Scholarship forms must be mailed to The Brookfield Theatre for the Arts at PO Box 528, Brookfield, CT 06804 and be received no later than May15 to be considered. All applicants will receive notification of scholarships awarded.

Applicant may be asked to provide proof of college acceptance before scholarships are awarded. Funds will be dispersed in June of each year. The Brookfield Theatre for the Arts reserves the right to select a single recipient, mutliple recipients, or no recipients in any calendar year.
