FROM THE DIRECTOR

The inimitable 19th century music hall comedian and clog-dancer Dan Leno said in his autobiography, Hys Booke, "There is nothing exceptional about being born. Birth is something that comes to all of us sooner or later...." And that needless to say is the same sentiment I have about directing The Complete Works of William Shakespeare (Abridged).
